

Five Year Household Growth

Texas contains five of the 10 fastest growing counties, and eight of the top 25. The suburban counties surrounding Washington DC occupy four of the top 15 slots. While warm weather southern locales dominate the growth rankings, three counties in Colorado and Utah also join the top 25 list.
